WHAT TO DO AFTER A CAR ACCIDENT

1 INJURIES

Medical care is obviously your main priority after being in an accident, even if you don't think you were hurt. Many injuries may not show symptoms immediately so it is important to seek medical treatment. Also, any injuries need to be documented for your claim.



2 CALL 911

CALL 911 FOR EMS AND POLICE HELP - Severe injuries require immediate medical help. The accident also needs to be documented. Police can talk to witnesses, get statements, document the scene, and file the accident report.

3 PICTURES

Take pictures and videos of the scene, your car, and the other car. It is rare to have too many pictures when handling an injury claim.



4 GATHER INFO

Gather contact information from the at-fault driver and witnesses. Don't rely solely on the accident report. Many times the accident report may reference a witness, but doesn't include their contact information.



5 ATTORNEY

Contacting an attorney is important. Attorneys can tell you what TO do: notify your insurance. Attorneys can tell you what NOT to do: posting your accident on socials. An attorney can evaluate your claim and demand fair compensation.
